

Sports Camp Staff: Junior Counselor

Position Summary: The Sports Camp Program Junior Counselors are responsible for knowing the whereabouts of each camper and facilitating the campers during camp hours.

Sports Camp Junior Coach Qualifications:

- Coaches must be at least 13 years of age
- Possess a desire and love to work with people of all ages, especially youth
- Possesses good responsibility skills
- Always demonstrates appropriate behavior i.e., patient, enthusiastic, self-controlled, and dependable
- Has the ability to work with others and follow directions

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- The Junior Counselor helps facilitate camp activities for the campers
- Responsible for knowing the whereabouts of each camper and assigned Junior Coaches during camp hours
- Monitors and ensures appropriate camper adherence to the camp program and rules
- Recognizes and responds to opportunities for problem-solving in the group of campers
- Facilitates the campers while participating in daytime camp activities
- Accompanies the campers to all daytime camp events
- Notifies the Lead Counselor or Director of Sports Ministry if he/she must be absent or late for duty for any reason
- Reports to work and from scheduled breaks on time
- Performs other duties as assigned
