Scripture from this week's sermon: <u>Ephesians 3:14-21</u>

- 1. Read <u>Ephesians 3:17</u>. Discuss what Paul is trying to show by using dimensions to explain God's love. How can we comprehend a love that "surpasses knowledge"?
- 2. Read <u>Ephesians 1:7</u>. There are three rich theological concepts in this verse. Discuss the meaning of "redemption," "by his blood" (atonement), and "forgiveness."
- 3. Read <u>Ephesians 1:13-14</u> and <u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u>. What characteristics of God's love are expressed in these verses?
- Pastor and author Tim Keller said that if he could start his ministry over, he would focus primarily on spiritual identity. Use the acronym S.S.A.F.E (Significant. Secure. Accepted. Forgiven. Empowered.) to discuss the importance of understanding who we are in Christ.
