Her parents taught her that human beings had the capacity to achieve a just and good world, but in their home, they suffered a lot of violence, alcoholism, and problems with the law due to fraud and scams. Having traveled to Spain, she, her mother, and brother met an evangelical pastor with whom she began to study the Bible and converted when she was 15 years old. Right away, she felt a very deep burden fto share Christ with others so they could have the same healing and hope that she experienced.

Fede and Lucia have four children, Andrea born in 2009, Eva in 2010, Veronica in 2012, and Simon in 2016.

Fede and Lucia work as church planters in Cabanillas del Campo. Fede is the pastor of the church. Lucia organizes and teaches the children's and teen programs. Together they do a lot of counseling with their church members, who are all first-generation Christians.
