their story

Juanpi is from Argentina and Celia is from Panama. They met at the Word of Life (WOL) Bible Institute in Argentina. They married in 2006 and immediately began working with WOL Panama. In 2008, they moved to the northwest province of Chiriqui, near the Costa Rican border, and launched a WOL ministry there. After nine years of living in Chiriqui, they moved back to Panama City in order to help the WOL staff with their children's program. They still minister in Chiriqui, but now from a distance.

During the school year, Juanpi and Celia lead Bible Clubs and minister through evangelistic drama productions. The goal of the Bible Clubs is to disciple the youth to be strong, biblically-sound leaders. Juanpi and Celia also visit schools in the area, presenting the Gospel in the elementary schools through puppets and in the secondary schools through dramas. They are presently members of a Chinese church, made up exclusively of young people, which allows them even more opportunities to minister to the youth of Panama.

During Panama's summer season, January through March, the Muls and the WOL team, run a summer camp program where the gospel is preached in various ways throughout each week. Hundreds of youth attend every year.

The Muls have a beautiful daughter, Emma, who was born in March 2016.
