Robin was raised in New Castle, PA and has attended The Bible Chapel since 2008. The Lord had been drawing Robin into ministry with orphans and vulnerable children for many years. This passion was kindled during a college internship at an orphanage in Romania in 1997. Robin has degrees in Bible and Missions and a Master's degree in Applied Developmental Psychology. She was a leader in The Bible Chapel's Foster Care and Adoption Ministry and worked full-time with young children with developmental delays. She also traveled internationally on many occasions to support the work of children's ministries in various countries.

In 2024, God called Robin to partner with The King's Kids, RD, a grassroots Christian ministry in the Piedra Blanca community of Jarabacoa. Partnering with Fellowship International Mission, Robin's ministry is to educate, equip and transform the lives of underprivileged children through the gospel of Jesus Christ.
