Overview

Chapel Kids Responsibilities

 - **Collaborating** with other TBC Teams in selecting children's curriculum and content.
 - **Recruiting** and training a team of volunteers to engage children from newborn to fifth grade.
 - **Communicate** with parents on the week's activities and send encouraging notes to Chapel Kids.
 - **Build** upon the fun discipleship culture that's represents Chapel Kids Ministry at The Bible Chapel.
 - Regular attendance at TBC church services, meetings, activities, staff functions, and events as required
 - Other Responsibilities: As assigned by the Campus Pastor.

- **Champion** the Chapel Students Ministry by:
 - **Developing** engaging regular ministry events, along with service opportunities, for Junior High and Senior High Students throughout the year.
 - **Shepherd and disciple** Chapel Students to courageously navigate and defend their faith in today's culture.
 - **Engage** Chapel Student Parents with ministry and message updates to bring the ministry conversation into the home.
 - **Create** and implement scope and sequence for Chapel Student gatherings and curriculum.
 - **Invest** in the lives of Chapel Students on their turf—attending school and community activities.
 - **Build** relationships within the primary school districts that represent Chapel Students in Robinson.
 - **Collaborate** with other Chapel Student Teams for encouragement, collaborative opportunities, and best practices.
 - **Lead**, recruit, and invest in Chapel Student volunteers to invest in Chapel Students.
 - Regular attendance at TBC church services, meetings, activities, staff functions, and events as required
 - Other Responsibilities: As assigned by the Campus Pastor.
