Objective

The Director of Worship will champion worship leading throughout our weekend services and offerings at the South Hills Campus of The Bible Chapel. This role will also oversee the development, teams, and planning of worship within our Student Ministries, carrying out and upholding the overall vision of The Bible Chapel.

Responsibilities

- Lead Weekend Worship Services at the South Hills Campus (2-3x a month)
- Manage weekend worship rehearsals as scheduled
- Collaborate in weekend service and set planning with a theological and creative grounding
- Generate creative service ideas for weekend and holiday services
- Shepherd the worship team with prayer, care, spiritual and skill development
- Champion a servant-leader mindset, prioritizing others on the team with opportunities to grow and lead on a weekly basis
- Collaborate with Tech Arts for an excellent audio/visual experience
- Infuse Team TBC into our volunteer structure with intentional development and collaboration with worship leadership team including recruitment, training, and onboarding
- Oversee worship planning, leading, and team building across our student ministries
- Collaborate with Student Leaders on vision/worship culture for students including sound, songs, and expression.
- Shepherd and train student worship team and leaders
- Research and implement worship songs and musical trends relevant to the next generation as appropriate and aligned with The Bible Chapels doctrine/Song Selection standards
- Attend weekly worship/production staff meeting
- Assist in song resource package creation
- Lead the recruitment, audition, and onboarding process for students
- Assist with the worship audition/on-boarding process for our weekend services
- Other responsibilities as assigned by the Supervisor

- Required proficiency in vocals and instrumentation as well as large group communication
- Must be able to prioritize projects, follow-thru on deadlines with attention to detail
