



Volunteer Frequently Asked Questions

Do volunteers need clearances?

*PA legislation requires background clearances. Act 153 requires every volunteer who is 18 years or older to have criminal background clearance, a PA Child Abuse Clearance, and FBI Fingerprinting (which you can be exempt from should you meet certain criteria). Should you need new clearances completed, you will be sent links electronically from our vendor, Justifacts. If you have any questions regarding background clearances, please contact Deanna Kratt, dkratt@biblechapel.org. **No volunteer will be allowed to participate without the appropriate background clearances.***
