

VBS Host Home Commitment

June 22-26, 2026



Hosting VBS is an opportunity to turn your home into a mission field for Jesus! Registration is open March 8th - April 12th.

What Do You Need?

- Be a Bible Chapel member and be home June 22-26!
- Have or obtain up to date clearances and background checks
- Desire to help children learn about Jesus and grow in their faith
- Commit to invite children to your neighborhood VBS
- Safe, relatively flat space for up to 25 kids to sit and to play games
- Storage space for 5-6 boxes of supplies plus decorations
- Easily accessible and available bathroom for children and volunteers
- Area for safe drop off and pick up for children
- Homeowner's insurance policy
- Alternate plan for bad weather – covered porch, empty garage, etc.

Expectations for Hosting VBS:

Prior to VBS Week

- Talk to families and children in your neighborhood and areas of influence about VBS
- Plan traffic flow, drop-off and pick-up areas
- Attend trainings to equip Host Homes for their missionary role
 - **NEW HOMES** will meet with their Host Home Coordinator for one-on-one training during the first few weeks of May.
 - May 3, 2026 - Pick up your manual, yard sign, and cards before or after one of the services for **ALL HOST HOMES**
 - June 3 **OR** June 8th, 2026 - VBS Training and Pick-Up Supplies for **ALL HOST HOMES** (6:30-8:00 PM)
 - Childcare will be provided for the June 8th training
- Display yard signs and invite friends' and neighbors' children, beginning May 3
- Host a Team Meeting for your VBS Neighborhood Team the week of June 13-21
- Be the Bible Chapel's contact person for the attending families and your VBS Team
- Pray – before VBS week, during VBS week, and after VBS week

Week of VBS

- Open your backyard to be a mission field to children and families
- Actively participate in what is being presented
- Provide coordination and support for your VBS Neighborhood Team, answer questions or find answers, help with time management
- Be available for families with questions – answer or find answers
- Be available an hour before and after your VBS times
- Show Jesus' love in your care for children, families, and other volunteers
- Pray with your VBS Neighborhood Team for your children, families, and activities
- Coordinate drop-off and pick-up for families
- Remind families that the last day of VBS (Fri, June 26) will be held at The Bible Chapel

After VBS

- Show Jesus' love in your communication with children and families touched by VBS
- Help with follow up to children who committed their lives to Jesus or asked for a Bible
- Return decorations and Host Home supplies to the church
